

## Intake Team

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**Before admission the following documents/records may be needed if available.**

- **In order to protect clients, staff, and the public, Santa Fe Recovery Center requires COVID-19 immunization. If you have not yet received a COVID-19 vaccination, Santa Fe Recovery Center can help coordinate this for you while in treatment. If you have not yet been vaccinated, we will provide a COVID-19 Rapid test upon admission.**
- In order to provide the best possible care, Santa Fe Recovery Center would like to have any medical history and an up to date medication list. (Clients should bring all medications including over the counter or supplements at intake time). If you do not have this, we can still admit you with any medication you do have.
- Santa Fe Recovery Center is able to assist clients on methadone. Clients will need to transfer their methadone services to one of the local clinics in Santa Fe (New Mexico Treatment Services (505-982-2129) or Santa Fe Health Services (505-820-9970). Santa Fe Recovery Center is happy to help coordinate this as well.
- Mothers with children 0-3 years old (for residential services only) please provide the following if available.
  - Most recent Well child check evaluation and up to date immunization records.
  - Children 1 year and older will require a recent PCR COVID-19 test.
  - Children 5 years and older will be required to receive a COVID-19 vaccination. If they have not yet to receive a COVID-19 vaccination Santa Fe Recovery Center can help coordinate.
